Class 2

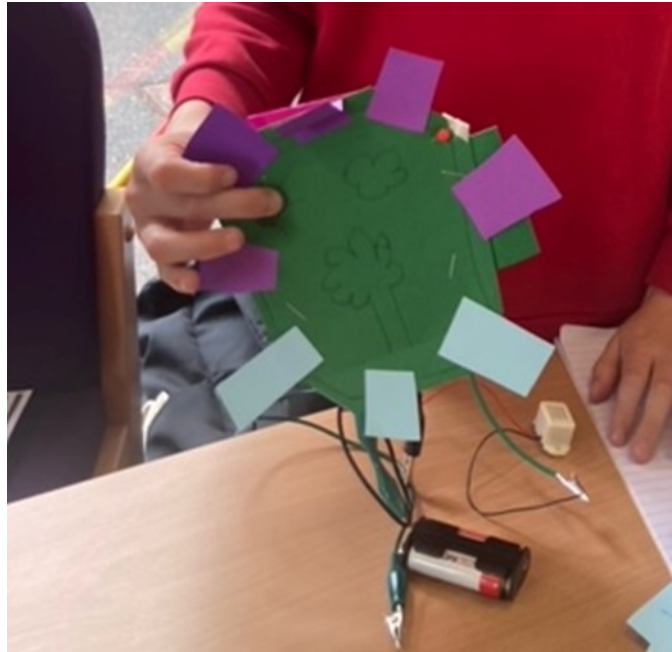
