Foston Nativity- Only EYFS / KS1

The plan is for the Nativity to go ahead on Tuesday 14th December in the Village Hall at 4pm. However, we have made the decision to only include the EYFS and KS1 children (Miss Midwood & Miss Allwood's class) in this performance and only these parents can attend. The junior children will get another opportunity to perform to parents their end of year play.

As you can understand, this has been a difficult decision, and could still be cancelled due to an increase in COVID cases or due to government guidance. At present, the government guidance is for nativities to continue. The Nativity is an event that families, staff and children enjoy each year and we would like to still make this memorable occasion happen. To ensure this event is as safe as possible, we will apply the following measures:

The room will be well ventilated with windows and doors open

- 1 adult can attend per family
- Masks must be worn, unless medically exempt
- Adults attending must complete a LFT before the event
- ♦ Chairs will be socially distanced between 1-2 metres
- ♦ Children will stay within their class groups

We understand that some families may not wish to attend this event. As the event is not within school hours, this is parental choice. Please can you let the office know if your child will not be taking part by Monday 3rd December. A video of the dress rehearsal will be taken and shared in January, for those who are unable to attend.

On the day, the EYFS/KS1 children can stay at school until 4pm and snacks will be provided before the Nativity. There will be a sports club, free of charge, for the juniors. We thank you for your support and understanding.
