Covid Updates

As you will be aware there have been further restrictions imposed nationally due to a new Covid variant. As a result North Yorkshire Council have sent us further school guidance. Please see points below;

- * Can we please ask that parents resume wearing masks at pick up and drop off and do not enter the school.
- Please be alert to the main Covid symptoms and the Delta variant symptoms of runny nose and sore throat and immediately take your child for a PCR.
- * If a family member tests positive, following Governmental guidance, children can still come to school, as long as they are displaying NO symptoms. We strongly advise you to go for a PCR test before returning to school and please be extra vigilant to any symptoms that may develop in the future.

At the moment we are currently looking into how the Nativity can proceed, this could possibly be with only certain classes, reduced parent attendance or over Teams, again all depending on guidance. At the moment guidance from North Yorkshire is that Nativities are to go ahead dependant on cases in the school and community. This does mean that we could have to cancel at very short notice we will keep you informed

Please can parents be aware that staff are working extremely hard to keep all the children safe and well. This has meant regular staff absences for PCR's to ensure that the many colds going around are not Covid related. Therefore please can we ask that you fully support staff by following the ever changing guidance they are receiving at this challenging time for us all. Our main aim at the moment is for everyone to have a lovely Christmas with their families undisturbed by Covid.

If we are to close due to bad weather please listen to BBC Radio York after 7.30am who will broadcast at regular intervals schools who are closed.
