Children will need to come to school in their PE kit, which is a white t-shirt, black shorts or jogging bottoms and trainers. **Please can children also wear their school jumper/cardigan.**



The children will be leaving Foston at 9:10am prompt to arrive at York LNER community stadium for a guided tour and a morning of activities centred on football, followed by an afternoon at school filled with sports involving balls. We will be back at school for lunchtime, however, on this day your child will require a packed lunch. Since we have recently taken part in our sports enhancement day, those children who ordered a school packed lunch will automatically be supplied one for this day with their previous sandwich choice, if there are any changes to this please can you let our school office know.

We will need your permission for your child to attend this, this can be done on parent-pay no later than **Monday 4th April** with a voluntary contribution of £8.50 per child to cover the costs of the bus, stadium tour and York City activities. Your child will be coming home with a sponsor form and we ask if you can collect sponsors for taking part in sports for the day with all sponsorship money raised going to our school charity Candle Lighters. Please can all children return their sponsorship forms with their money on the day of the visit, we thank you for your continued support.

Head Lice
