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Important Request about Parking

Askham-Bryan Wildlife Park KS2

On Friday 10th June KS2 children, years 3-6, will be going on a school trip to Askham-Bryan Wildlife Park. The trip will link to the science topic of 'Animals including Humans' and the children will be completing a workshop on classifying. Please can we ask for a voluntary contribution of £12per pupil, which will be made through Parent Pay. School packed lunches are available, please can these be ordered through the School Office by **Friday 27th May** - there is a choice of cheese, ham or egg sandwich.

Phonics screening—Year 1

The first week after half term, Year 1 children will be completing the national phonics screening check. This is a short, statutory assessment to ensure that children are making progress in the phonics skills to read words and are on track to become fluent readers who can enjoy reading for pleasure and for learning. The test contain 40 words. Each child sits one to one and reads each word aloud to their teacher. If you have any questions regarding this, please contact school.

Multiplication Tables Check - Year 4

On week commencing the 20th June, the year 4 children will be completing the new statutory Multiplication Tables Check. The test will be done using iPads or laptops and the children will have to answer 25 questions on times tables 2 to 12. For every question they will have 6 seconds to answer and in between the questions there is a 3-second rest. Questions about the 6, 7, 8, 9, and 12 times table come up more often.

To help prepare the children for this check, please can we ask that they practise their times tables regularly at home using Times Tables Rock Stars, Hit the Button or through answering quick fire questions.
