

Frequently Asked Questions

When can my child start nursery?

Children can start from their 3rd birthday

Do the current staff have the relevant qualifications?

Miss Midwood is a qualified teacher and Miss Hendry is a qualified nursery teaching assistant.

Will funding cover all my nursery costs?

Funding may be used for main nursery sessions and breakfast and after school club is available. You may purchase additional hours so your child can attend more sessions than just your entitlement, for the cost of £4.50 per hour. Children in nursery may receive a school lunch at the cost of £2.50 per day, payable using Parent Pay.
