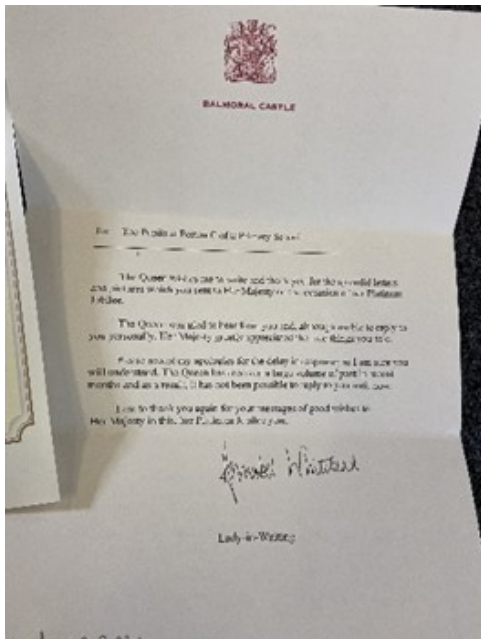
We have started our new topic 'All About Me', looking at ourselves and our families.

Also, a long time ago, we wrote to the Queen to wish her well on her Platinum Jubilee.

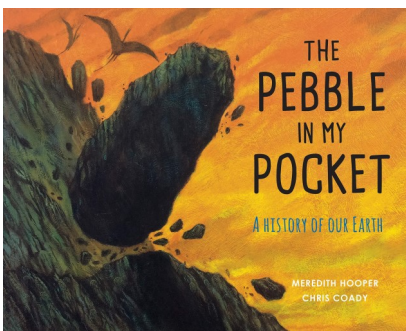
This week we received a reply! We were all very excited to read what she had written and to look at the things that she had sent us.

We have started our new book, 'The Pebble in my Pocket', and have been exploring pebbles in our surrounding areas.



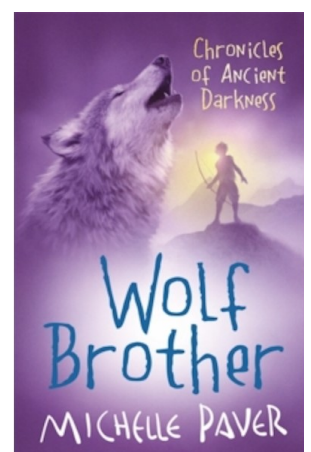
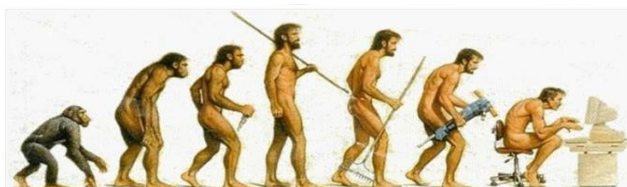
The children have created great descriptive sentences about the pebbles we have found. Well done Class 3!
