
#### Nursey & Reception

This week in Nursery and Reception we have continued our learning about celebrations, focussing on birthdays. #### Years 1 & 2

A child from class said, "We learnt about oceans, marine life, ocean names, transportation of the ocean and geological phenomena like human uses.
