


### Years 3 & 4

#### Message from Governors

The consultation on our proposal to form a new federation of Foston, Stillington and Terrington Schools has now ended. Governors will be considering the responses received at separate meetings on 28<sup>th</sup> February and 6<sup>th</sup> March, and will decide whether to move to the new FST Primary Schools Federation.

If Governors decide it is in the best interests of all three schools to form the new federation, this would be from 28<sup>th</sup> March 2023, when the current Governing Bodies would be dissolved and a new Governing Body for the three schools would be formed which would have 2 Parent Governors, elected by parents from across the three schools. Please watch out for details of the role of a Parent Governor, the election process and nomination forms which will be e-mailed to all parents on Monday. We are pleased that some governors from both GBs wish to continue to serve, providing continuity and their skills and experience. One current parent governor will stand for re-election.

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## School Drop Off & Collection

Due to the busyness of drop off and collection please can we ask that this is done swiftly to allow others to park, we have limited parking spaces, some parents are having to park their cars on the road making drop off and collection unsafe.

## Wrap Around Care & Extra-Curricular

Please can I remind you that all wrap around care and extra-curricular must be rebooked each half term. ### <u>Muslim Day</u>

This term the KS2 children have been learning all about the Muslim religion in Religious Education. On Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> March children in KS2 (Mr Carlisle and Miss Stringer/Mrs Richmond's classes) will be having a Muslim day, taking place at Stillington Primary School.

The children will be picked up from school after 9am and will be back in time for pick up at the end of the school day. The day will see the children baking, looking at Muslim artefacts and art and having a Muslim educational leader in school to talk to them all about the Muslim Religion. Children can order a school lunch on the day as normal or bring a packed lunch with them to take to Stillington. We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £7.50 to cover the cost of the day, payable through ParentPay.
