It is important that we are aware of the expected numbers so we can order sufficient food/snacks. Staff members leading the clubs will therefore be aware in advance of confirmed numbers. In emergencies, we will try to cater at short notice, however, this is not always possible.

As a school, we must follow our safeguarding and attendance procedures. Parents/carers will receive a phone call if children are booked into breakfast care and do not arrive or are not collected at the time specified from afterschool care.
