
FOSTON PRIMARY SCHOOL BULLETIN

Year 1 & 2

We noticed that there are similarities between the stories that are special to Muslims and those that are special to Christians.



Year 3 & 4

In DT this week, Class 3 have been making waving pop-ups using levers and linkages. They created amazing designs and used their DT skills, cardboard and split pins to create their waving pop-ups.





Year 5 & 6

This week in Class 4 we have been continuing our science investigation with gravity and magnets. We have also been making our own papyrus as part of our learning about Ancient Egypt and Tutankhamun himself approved this! In English we finished our information text about Charon, the ferryman from Greek mythology.
