Nursery & Reception

It has been lovely to welcome the children back and hear about the different things they have done during the Easter holidays. This week we started our new topic of 'People Who Help Us' discussing lots of different jobs and which job we might like to do when we grow up. <u>Year 3 & 4</u>

It is finally Summer term, at Foston and we can't wait for the sun to come out! Our overall topic in Summer Term 1 is 'What are our local areas like?'

For Class 3, our English work will be based on the famous book: 'The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe.' In Maths, we will be continuing our work on fractions and measurements.



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<u>Year 5 & 6</u>

Welcome back! This week in Class 4 we have started our new class text: Goodnight Mister Tom. We are looking at the setting descriptions in our writing, the children have made some very good predictions and linked their ideas to existing knowledge. In Maths, we are learning about perimeter and are starting to look at some really complex shapes.

KS2 Howsham Mill Trip
